Backup components



Setup should always include planning for backup implant components with different abutment lengths to correspond to the soft tissue thickness. Consider whether there is a need for backup components and instruments for an alternative technique.*

A Caution

The MONO drill must always be used together with the cannula. The cannula provides the stop that prevents drilling deeper than intended.
